

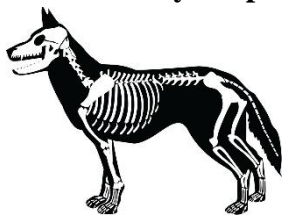

We have recently upgraded our digital X-ray machine to a newer, faster and more advance model. Radiography is an imaging technique using X-rays to produce an image allowing us to view the internal structures of your pets!

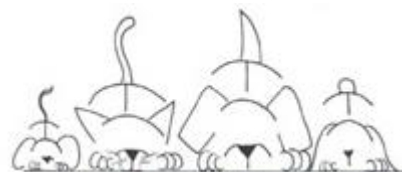
New Staff
